WASHINGTON, Oct. 3.—Franklin D. Roosevelt today announced that he had returned to his home in Warm Springs, Ga., after a long and arduous journey. The President, who has been confined to a wheelchair since his attack of polio in 1921, said he was "feeling better" and "able to walk" for the first time in years. He added that he was "very glad" to be back in his home and to be able to "enjoy the life" of Warm Springs.
